This article is about one of such great people, scientist Malika Abdullakhojayeva, who made a great contribution to the science of pathological anatomy. It is dedicated to Samatovna. Abdullaxjayeva Malika Samatovna was the director of the Pathological Anatomical Center of the Republic, Hero of Uzbekistan, Honored Scientist of Uzbekistan, Academician of the Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Uzbekistan, Doctor of Medical Sciences, Professor.

Malika Abdullakhojayeva Samatovna was born on November 28, 1932 in Moscow, Russia. After graduating from the 110th secondary school of Tashkent with a gold medal, in 1950 he was admitted to the medical faculty of the Tashkent State Medical Institute (ToshDTI). During her studies, she became a state scholarship holder, the chairman of the students of the scientific community. Malika Samatovna began her scientific career in the scientific circle under the pathologic anatomy (1953-1956) during her student years. In recent years, Malika Samatovna continued her work on the study of reactive and pathological processes of the central nervous system. In 1956, after graduating from ToshDTI with excellent grades, Malika Samatovna entered the post-graduate course of the Brain Institute of the USSR Academy of Medical Sciences on December 27, 1960. became a doctor of sciences. In 1969, Malika Samatovna was

elected to the department of pathological anatomy, in 1970 she was awarded the title of professor, and her students developed a program on the problems of neuropathology and neuromorphology Professor M.S. Abdullahojayeva is a well-known scientist in clinical immunopathology and experimental field. Another direction of his research and with his students was the study of complications and pathogenesis of pathological anatomy in pregnancy. For 35 years, while he was the head of the department of pathological anatomy of the Medical Institute of Malika Samatovna, he trained highly qualified doctors, a higher educational institution in the field of medicine. made a great contribution to the training of pedagogues, doctors of medical sciences. After the separation of the First and Second ToshDTI in 1990, the scientist headed the department of pathological anatomy of the Second ToshDTI until 2000. In 1997-1999, he created the 2-volume textbook "Human Pathological Basis" at medical universities. In 1995, M.S. Abdullahhojayeva became a corresponding member of the Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Uzbekistan, and in 2000, she became a full member. From 1972 to 1997, he made a great contribution to the development of pathological anatomy as the chief pathological anatomist of the Republic of Uzbekistan in terms of health care. For the first time, an internship department of pathological anatomy was established, a department of pathological anatomy Today, on his initiative, the only Republican center of pathological anatomy in the CIS countries was established. In its base, masters of all medical specialties receive training, clinical experience is conducted, and 5 departments: pathogistology, bacteriology, virology, cytology laboratories are working. RPM laboratory, electron microscopy, medicine and molecular genetics, as well as biotechnology cell laboratory were established. Thead of the Central Scientific Research Laboratory of the Uzbekistan Institute of Radiology, Radiology and Oncology (1963-69), Head of the Pathomorphology and Histochemistry Laboratory of the Uzbekistan Institute of Radiology, Radiology and Oncology (1963-69), TashTI (1969-1990), since 1990, head of the Department of Pathological Anatomy of the 2nd TashTI Abdullahojayeva's scientific works are mainly devoted to the issues of immunopathology of the nervous system, geographical pathology and the history of

medicine. She is the founder of a new direction in the field of medicine in Uzbekistan - transplant immunopathology. The first pathological anatomy textbook published in Uzbek and Russian (1997) author. Honorary citizen of the state of California (since 1986). In 2005, under the guidance of M.S. Abdullahojoyeva is the founder of the large scientific-pedagogical and practical school of pathological anatomy: under her leadership, 13 doctors of medical sciences and 58 candidates of medical sciences have graduated. Today, his students work not in large medical centers of Uzbekistan, but in a number of Central Asian regions, as well as in Russia, Israel, India, Yemen, Egypt, Nepal, and the USA. M.S. Abdullahojoyeva has several state awards: the Order of "Veteran of Labor" (1970), the Order of "Badge of Honor" (1976), the honorary title of "Honored Scientist of Uzbekistan" (1980), "Hero of Labor" Order (1984), "Excellence of Higher Education" (2000), "Fame of Labor" (2003). In 2006, by the decision of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, M.S. Abdullahojoyeva was awarded the title of "Hero of Uzbekistan" and "Golden Star". The Academy of Sciences of Uzbekistan suffered a severe divorce. Hero of Uzbekistan, academic woman Abdullahojoyeva Malika Samatovna died on June 26, 2018.
