By developing personal competence, the child is at preschool age exhibits a number of characteristics that are formed and improved throughout its life. This competency includes the child's ability to take responsibility for self-care and the skills to manage daily life and practice a sustainable healthy lifestyle.

Cognitive competence includes the ability to acquire knowledge, read and learn, independently search, analyze and select the necessary information to understand the environment. Therefore, in the process of preparing children for school education, it is important to form basic competencies in an integrated manner.

In many psychological and pedagogical literature, the concept of "readiness for school" is a characteristic feature of the development of a person as a person, it is expressed by the scale of psychological, psycho-mental characteristics in a child, without which it is impossible to successfully master educational activities at school.

According to V.V.Davidov, "readiness for school is a set of morphophysiological and psychological characteristics of an older preschool child, the systematic organization of which ensures a successful transition to school."

The main goals and objectives of the competence approach in preschool education are determined as a result of:

- I) value the acquisition and manifestation of competence occurs in the process of mastering the content of preschool education;
- 2) the goal when competence combines the development of intelligence and skills (knowledge, skills, abilities, experience, relationships), education implementation of socialization and individualization.;
- 3) the resulting competence includes a number of skills (communicative, informational, language, social, personal, etc.) that are close to each other in the field of action and activity.
